

Admission policies

For Egyptian students:

- 1- The student must have a high school completion certificate from the Arab Republic of Egypt or an equivalent secondary degree from a scientific institution recognized by the university and the Supreme Council of Universities.
- 2- To join the college, registration is required within a maximum period of five (5) weeks from the beginning of the academic year. If the student applies for registration after the end of the specified period, the student will be accepted into the college and his enrollment will be suspended during that academic year and his enrollment will be re-enrolled at the beginning of the next academic year.
- 3- The tuition fees must be paid according to what is determined by the administration on the specified date announced by the college.
- 4- Lists of those accepted into the program are announced by the coordination office through nomination cards

For International Students:

*The international educational program is subject to the admission and transfer policy for expatriates in accordance with the regulatory laws of the Egyptian Ministry of Higher Education

*Due to the admission policies of the expatriate administration, it is the one who announces their acceptance and it is the one that determines the admission procedures and policies.

*The lists of those accepted into the program are announced by the Expatriates Department via the Expatriates Department website

*Fees for international students are set at ten thousand dollars annually
